Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Breakfast and After-School Club provision is being refreshed to ensure we continue to provide the best possible service. This provision is an extension of the school day and mirrors all the expectations and initiatives already within the school, such as Growth Mindset and Mutual Respect.

We ensure we are offering a range of activities, which children can carousel around freely if they so wish. These include an outdoor activity (weather permitting), an art/craft station, a computer-based station, a healthy food preparation station, a quiet reading and reflection area and a technical/construction area. The children who attend will be involved in the selection and review of these activities fortnightly.

Healthy snacks are on offer each day, such as salad cuts and fresh fruit, as well as the tasty meals, which the children assist to prepare, such as pasta, soup, rice, not to mention the old favourites of spaghetti and beans on toast. A fortnightly rotating menu will be used devised by the Manager.

We have now got a new mobile phone, that receives incoming calls only and is used during the After-School club session time. The hope is that parents can use the mobile number to notify After-School Club staff if they are going to be late or of an emergency, or to notify staff of their arrival, because the After-School club is outside of the range of the doorbell.

This number is only to be used for the purposes described above. Please remember it is not to be used to book children in for After-School club.

Please remember that Breakfast and After-school clubs now operate under a **“Pay as you Go”** policy, meaning that when parents drop their children off in the morning from 8:00 AM they must pay the £2.00 charge. If children are dropped off no earlier than 8:30 AM for breakfast provision only, the cost will be simply £0.20. Similarly, for after-school club, parents after booking their child into the club in advance must pay the charge of £4.00 for half a session, £5.50 for a full session without tea or £6.50 for a full session with tea on collection. These prices are per child. If no payment has been made after a week, parents will not be able to use the service, until the amount owed is paid in full. Paying in advance remains absolutely fine.

Children, who are late being picked up on a regular/daily basis (after 3:20 PM in the main school or after 3:40 PM in the Nursery), will be put into After-School club for reasons of safety and supervision. Parents of these children will need to speak to Mr. Young, as this may incur a charge of £1.00. Those families, who have children in more than one school, will not be charged this fee, as we understand the difficulties surrounding this with schools finishing at the same time.

We are proud of all the extra services and clubs we continue to have on offer to assist families and trust that these new changes will improve upon these further.
